CompTIA Security+™ certification is an internationally recognized validation of the technical knowledge required of foundation-level security practitioners. CompTIA Security+ candidates will have a minimum of two years experience in networking with an emphasis on security. They should also have prepared using adequate study materials or formal training. The objectives of the CompTIA Security+ exam were derived through input from industry, government and academia, through a job task analysis and a survey of more than 300 organizations with participants from 26 countries.
